MT. LEBANON, PENNSYLVANIA
ORDINANCE NO. 2994

AN ORDINANCE OF MT. LEBANON, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING
CHAPTER II, (BUILDINGS) OF THE MT. LEBANON CODE BY ADDING
PART 3, (HOURS AND CONDITIONS OF WORK).

Mt. Lebanon, Pennsylvania, ordains as follows: that Chapter II, (Buildings) of the Mt. Lebanon Code be amended by adding Part 3 as follows:

Part 3. Hours and Conditions of Work

Section 301. All public and private exterior construction, demolition and grading work shall be performed between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m., Monday through Saturday, unless the Permittee obtains written consent from the Manager or his/her agent to do the work at an earlier or later hour. Such permission shall be granted only in the case of an Emergency or in the event the work authorized by the permit is to be performed in traffic-congested areas.


Section 302. In granting any permit, the Manager may attach such other conditions thereto as may be reasonably necessary to prevent damage to public or private property or to prevent the operation from being conducted in a manner hazardous to life or property or in a manner likely to create a public nuisance, including without limitation, the following:

- Section 302.1 limitations on the period of the year in which the work may be performed;
- Section 302.2 restrictions as to the size, weight, and type of equipment;
- Section 302.3 designation of routes upon which materials may be transported;
- Section 302.4 designation of the place and manner of disposal of excavated materials;
- Section 302.5 requirements as to the control of dust, the cleaning of Streets, the prevention of noise, and other results offensive or injurious to the neighborhood, the general public, or any portion thereof; and
- Section 302.6 regulations as to the use of Streets in the course of the work.


Section 303. The use of a mechanical device for the breaking of pavement, such as a hydra-hammer or headache ball, will be permitted only under special written permission of the Manager.
